Music Scholarships are open to students who will be entering Years 7–10 in 2024. These scholarships will be awarded to students who show excellence in their music ability as well as their learning, and are actively involved within their current school and in out-of-school activities. Successful applicants will be positive communicators and hold a passion for learning and new experiences. Scholarship recipients will be expected to support and be involved in the school music program, wearing the Sacré Cœur uniform with pride.

Application Process

1. Register for the Academic Test via our website at www.sac.vic.edu.au/scholarships. Payment of a \$120 fee is required.
2. Parents are to complete all sections of this application form. Please print clearly.
3. Provide copies of your daughter's most recent NAPLAN results, her last two school reports and AMEB (or equivalent) certificates.

Shortlisted applicants may be invited to an audition and may also be required to meet with the Principal, Ms Adelina Melia-Douvos. Please note that submission of this form does not guarantee an audition or interview for a scholarship.

Successful applicants will be made a formal offer. To secure the place offered, payment of the non-refundable enrolment confirmation fee and scholarship deposit (for new students), along with signed acceptance of both the Scholarship offer and Business Terms will be required by the date specified.

Music Scholarships provide partial remission of tuition fees to the end of Year 12, subject to the student's continuing superior performance and her ongoing contribution to the life of Sacré Cœur, including involvement in the Music program at the School. This will be assessed on an annual basis and unsatisfactory performance may result in the withdrawal of scholarship entitlements.
