General Excellence Scholarship Application Form

VCE including Years 10, 11 and 12 2024

Please note Sacré Cœur offers a range of VCE Unit 1 and 2 subjects in Year 10. This allows students to complete six Unit 3 and 4 VCE subjects which contributes another 10% to their ATAR.

General Excellence Scholarships are open to new students who will be entering Years 10–12 in 2024. These Scholarships will be awarded to students who show excellence in their learning and are actively involved within their current school and out-of-school activities. Successful applicants will be positive communicators and hold a passion for learning and new experiences. Scholarship recipients will be expected to support and be involved in school activities and events, wearing the Sacré Cœur uniform with pride.

Application Process

1. Register for the Academic Test via our website at www.sac.vic.edu.au/scholarships. Payment of a \$120 fee is required.
2. Parents are to complete all sections on pages 2–3 of this application form, and sign on the bottom of page 4. Please print clearly.
3. Your daughter is to complete the candidate section on page 4 of the application form.
4. Provide copies of your daughter's most recent NAPLAN results and her last two school reports.

Shortlisted applicants may be invited to an interview with the Principal, Ms Adelina Melia-Douvos. (Please note that submission of this form does not guarantee an interview for a scholarship).

Successful applicants will be made a formal offer. To secure the place offered, payment of the non-refundable enrolment confirmation fee and scholarship deposit along with signed acceptance of both the Scholarship offer and Terms and Conditions of Enrolment will be required by the date specified.

Partial remission of tuition fees to the end of Year 12 is provided, subject to the student's continuing superior performance and her ongoing contribution to the life of Sacré Cœur. This will be assessed on an annual basis and unsatisfactory performance may result in the withdrawal of Scholarship entitlements.
